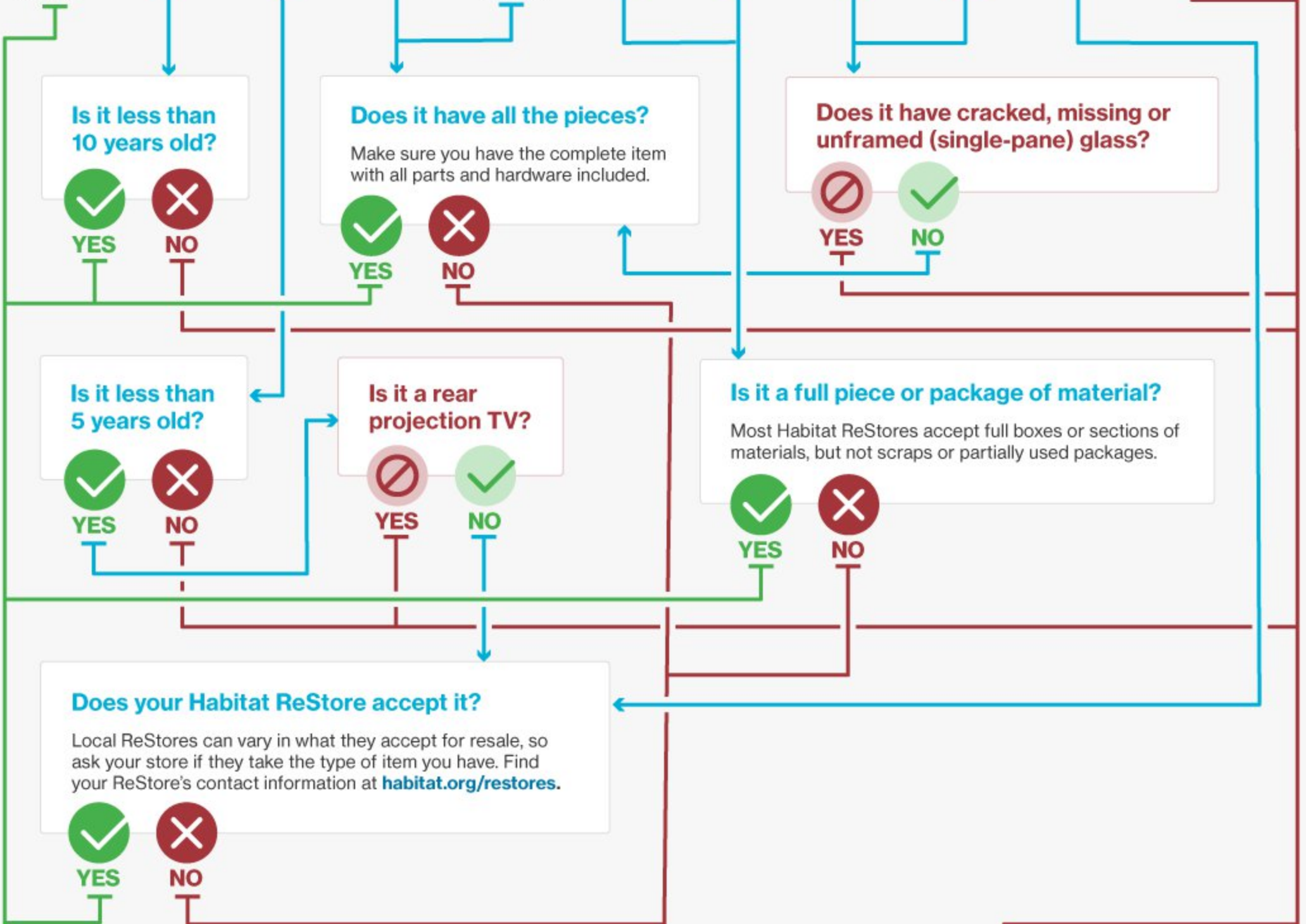
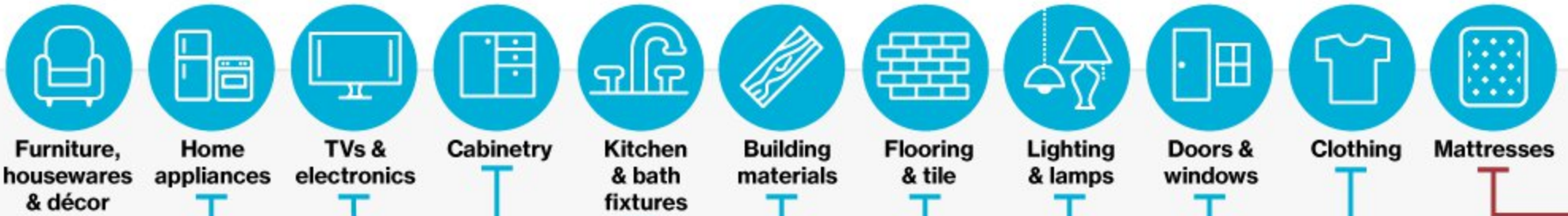
i Habitat ReStores' donation guidelines help lower waste removal costs so that more proceeds can go to support Habitat's work.

Is it in good condition and full working order?

Your item should be fully functioning and have no missing or broken parts, deep scratches, chips or cracks, fabric with stains, tears or strong odors, or other major damage.
